Monte Carlo Yachts 86

The new flagship of the Monte Carlo Yachts range – the MCY 86 – will make its world debut at the Cannes Boat Show in September.

The 86 is looking to build on the success of the yard's other three models, the 65, 70 and 76 as it nudges its way towards the superyacht sector.

As such there are a host of new features like optional folding balconies on either side of the dining area (not shown in the exterior rendering), a vast

open-plan saloon and a very high level of customisation. This includes a wide variation of layouts so that owners can choose between a three, four or five-cabin design. The full-beam owner's suite is particularly luxurious with its own office and walk-in wardrobe.

The big boat design cues continue on deck where the traditional MCY covered side decks reappear as do the Portuguese bridge and foredeck seating area plus the carbon fibre T-top

with soft opening sunroof. There is the option to fit a jacuzzi on the top deck, adding to the luxury sunbathing, wet-bar and lounging areas already up there.

MCY makes a point of stressing how carefully it has chosen the materials and fabrics on board to feel as special as possible, including cedarstone marble, alabaster and Venetian mosaics handmade from Murano glass.

Twin MAN 1,800hp engines provide the grunt and will see the 86 to a top

speed of 29 knots. It will undoubtedly feel very comfortable cruising at displacement speeds as well.
