

## MCY 76 SKYLOUNGE SET FOR CANNES

Italian builder Monte Carlo Yachts predicts an August launch for its first MCY 76 Skylounge, which follows the MCY 70 Skylounge that debuted in February.

onte Carlo Yachts is ready to launch the second model of its Skylounge Collection, the MCY 76 Skylounge, at the end of the summer. However, which boat show would host the model's world premiere had yet to be confirmed by late June. Last year, Monte Carlo Yachts began its second decade with the

launch of the new MCY 70, 66 and 76 – which replaced the company's original 70, 65 and 76 respectively. The builder is now offering a skylounge option on the larger two models, with the world premiere of the MCY 70 Skylounge held at this year's Miami Yacht Show in February.

The Nuvolari Lenard studio designed the new Skylounge series,



having worked on all of Monte Carlo Yachts' models since the builder was founded in 2008. Carlo Nuvolari and Dan Lenard designed a wide, customisable enclosed flybridge, allowing the top deck to be used in colder seasons or inclement weather.

"We focused on designing a yacht able to offer a close connection with the sea, also providing maximum comfort on a craft that is meant to be enjoyed at all times of the year," said the Venice-based duo.

"The result is a model that embodies a perfect balance between functionality and aesthetics, making each day onboard a unique and pleasurable experience."

The MCY 76 Skylounge offers a wide aft terrace on the upper deck, with an open-air galley and a lounge area to be customised according to the owners' preferences.

The skylounge's versatile internal area also include the yacht's sole helm station. This allows more social space on the main deck, where a flexible layout can extend to the aft cockpit's wide al fresco dining area. Owners can choose among a wide range of high-quality textures and materials in order to decorate the yacht according to their taste.

Monte Carlo Yachts is represented by Asia Yachting in Hong Kong, Macau and five Southeast Asian countries – Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore and Thailand. <sup>5</sup>
